9:30 - 10:30	<u>Horrible Chords Demystified</u> <u>Sally Carter</u> Newcastle Room	Sally Carter will show you how to play familiar chord shapes all over the fretboard, allowing you to play traditionally horrible chords with ease. Avoid barre chords and funk up your playing with plucking chords that only use 2 or 3 strings.
10:00 - 11:00	<u>Ukulele for Kids</u> <u>Tom the Pom</u> The Playhouse	The ukulele is the world's second best* instrument, so let's have a go. Borrow one of Tom's ukes or bring your own. Tom the Pom has taught bazillions of people, online and in person, from whole classes of primary aged kids to corporate training. He's been on TV, he's played shows. Suitable for children aged 8 to 108. Parents welcome to learn along with the kids
11:00 - 12:00	<u>Strumalong</u> <u>Tyrone and Lesley</u> Newcastle Room	This experience, open to players of all skill levels, offers learning around half-chords, simple strumming and basic choral singing. Once you register for the workshop you'll have access to a package on online materials (chord chart, friendly instructional video) which will give you head start, if you want, and within the session we'll cover key and incidental skills in playing and singing with uke in groups. Your participation in the concert is envisaged as a beautiful surprise: optional, low-stress, played from your position in the audience, and we'll talk more about it on the day.
11:30 - 12:30	<u>Bringing Rhythm to the Uke</u> <u>Joe Man Murphy</u> The Playhouse	Joe Man Murphy presents this fun interactive workshop breaking down rhythm on Ukulele. As a full time music teacher Joe Man has a wealth of knowledge to share and a great understanding of the finer details of playing rhythm. Bring a ukulele and take your playing to the next level!
12:30 - 1:30	<u>Spice up your Strumming</u> <u>Cameron Murray</u> Newcastle Room	Cameron is known for his fast and complex strums and he'll break down some of his techniques so you can take your performance to the next level...or just have more fun with your uke! This workshop is aimed at intermediate players, but ukers of all levels will get something out of it.
1:00 - 2:00	<u>Ukulele Death Squad</u> The Playhouse	The Squad bring a magnetizing and infatuating energy to the uke through the creation of their own Flamenco, Mexicana, RnB and folk style.
2:00 - 3:00	<u>Beginning Song Writing</u> <u>Jane Cameron</u> Newcastle Room	Jane is a prolific songwriter releasing 3 EPs and a double album since first picking up the uke in 2010, with another album due for release in late 2022. She is on a mission to show that song writing can be quick, easy, playful and FUN! This workshop is for anyone who has ever wanted to write a song and didn't know where to start and for those who have started song writing but are suffering from writer's block.
2:30 - 3:30	<u>Utter Beginners Ukulele</u> <u>Sum of The Parts (Mark Jackson and Jane Jelbart)</u> The Playhouse	All you need is one step to make either of these realities come true: your first ukulele lesson. We'll have ukes to loan you, or you can bring your own, and we'll tune it for you. We'll teach you how to play 3-4 songs in this fun and quick absolute beginners lesson. Not played before or need a refresher - this is for you. We go through the basics including: how to hold the ukulele; what are the strings (G,C,E,A); 8 basic chords; basic strum patterns; left and right hand positions.
